Frequently asked questions:

Q: Where are these trees grown?

A: The trees are grown in the Pacific Northwest. All of our trees come from premium Christmas tree farms in Washington and Oregon.

Q: What kinds of trees do you offer?

A: We offer three varieties: Douglas Fir, Noble Fir and Grand Fir.

Q: How do your trees differ from the trees on conventional tree lots?

A: The major difference is the quality. Our trees are all premium "nursery quality" trees guaranteed to be fresh.

Q: How fresh are these trees? How long can they be expected to last in my home?

A: Our trees are harvested just 72 hours before they're loaded onto trucks bound for your destination. Unlike conventional retailers' trees, which were likely cut weeks before Thanksgiving, your tree can be expected to last through the holiday season.

Q: Isn't it harmful to the environment to be cutting down all these trees?

A: Our trees are grown on farms and are 100% recyclable. For every tree cut, new seedlings are planted.

Q: What if there's a problem with my tree when I receive it?
